Item 4. Unfinished Business

4A) Final Reading of Ordinance 09-09

Motion was made by Councilor Minor, seconded by Councilman McRady, to approve third and final reading of Ordinance 09-09. This ordinance will permit establishments, where no alcoholic beverages are sold, to allow members or their guests/customers to provide their own alcoholic beverages upon paying a fee or other consideration for admission, membership or setups. 6B) Discussion was held pertaining to the City's Beer Ordinance concerning the issue of beer permits to non citizens of the United States.

Councilor Minor commented this was a violation of state law and the ordinance needed to be amended.

Councilman McRady agreed by stating the State Attorney General's Office states it is unconstitutional to deny this permit upon citizen status.

The City Attorney will be contacted for his advice on this item.
