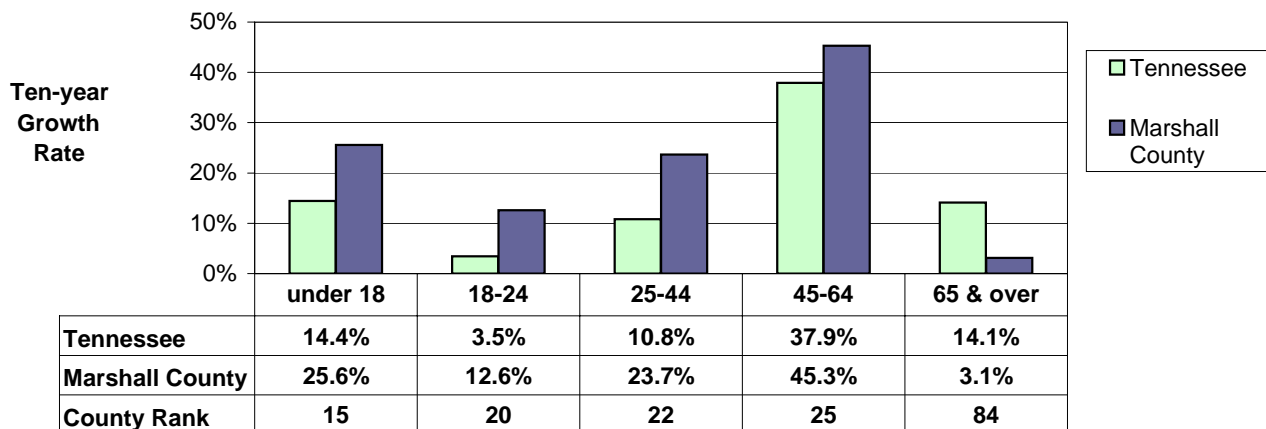

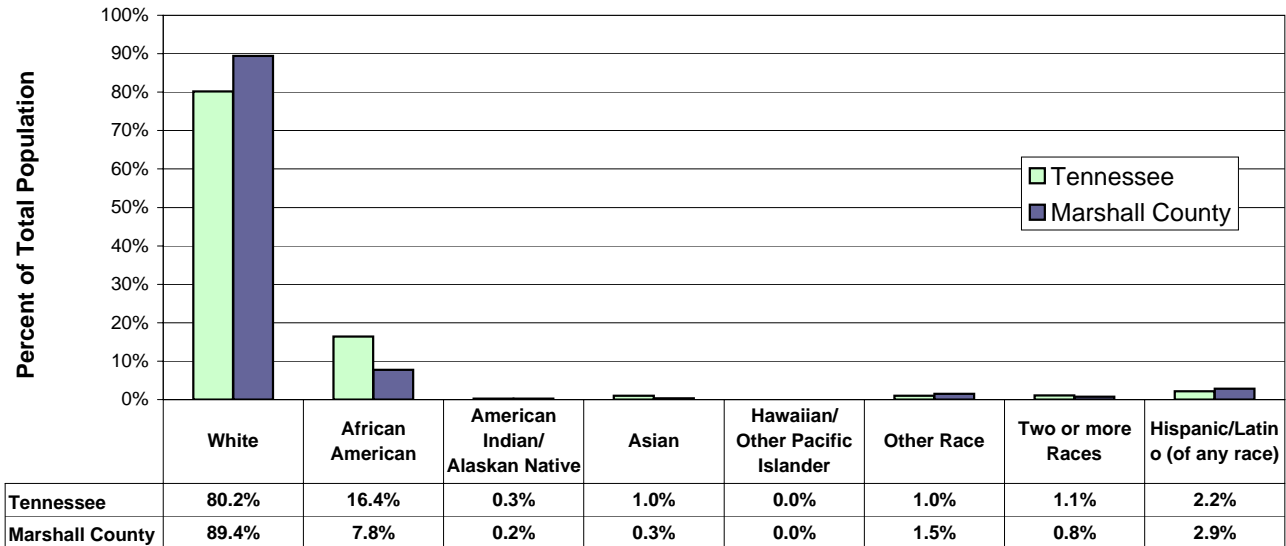
Population Growth by Age Bracket, 1990 to 2000

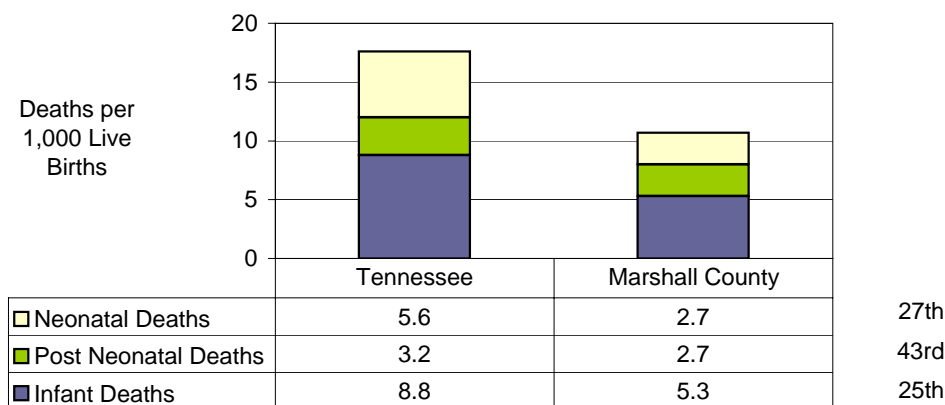

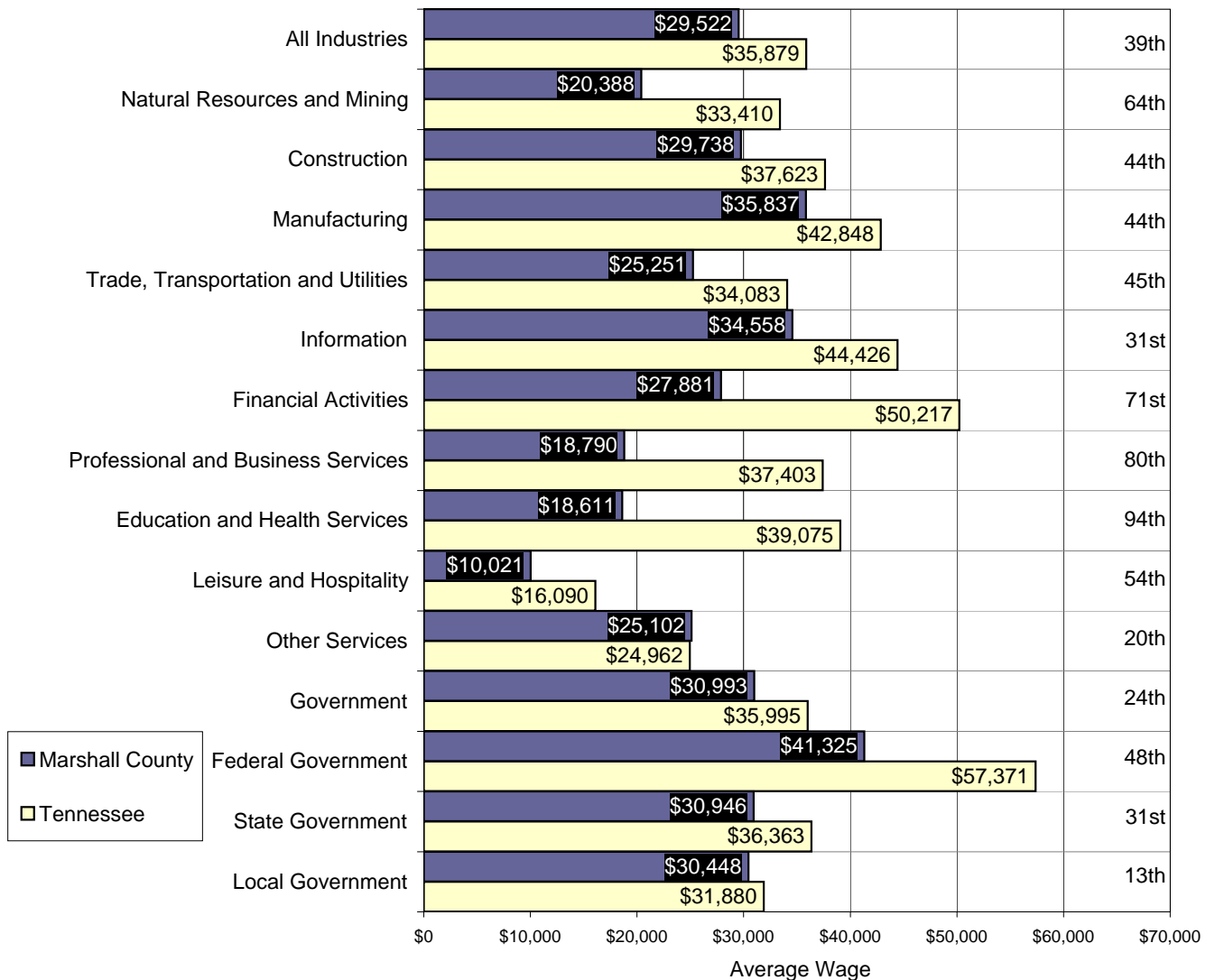

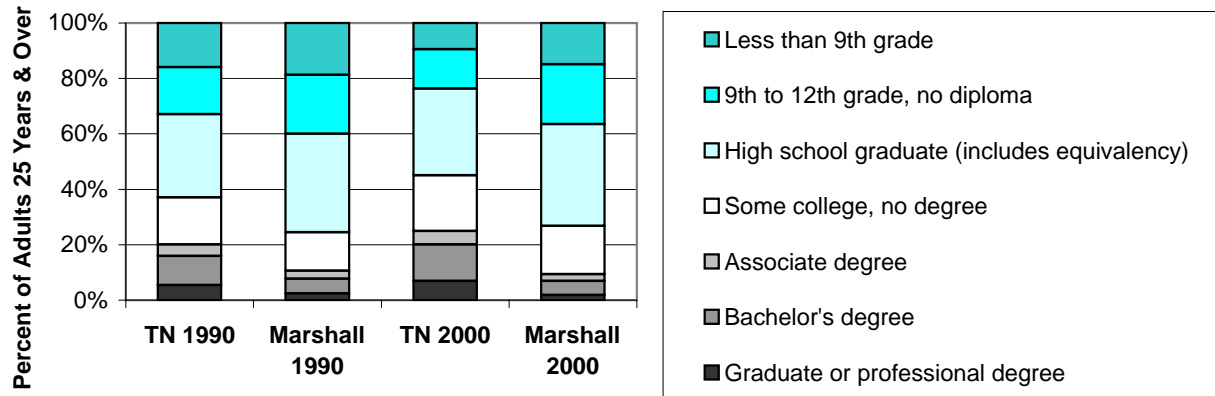
